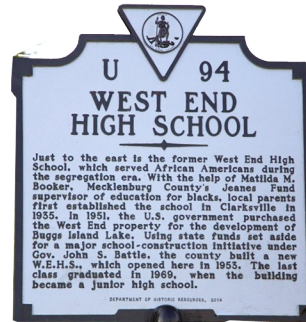
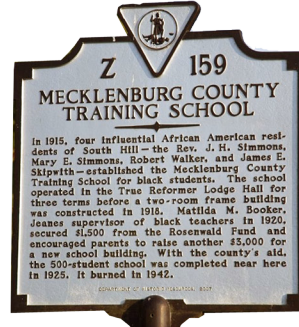
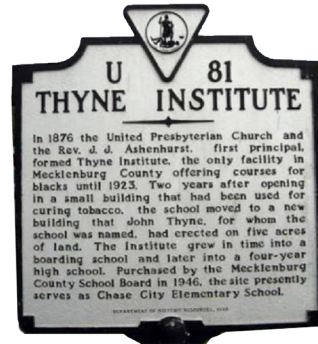

The Historically Black Schools of Mecklenburg County, VA, Inc. came into existence January 2014, achieved incorporated status September of the same year and was granted IRS Code 501(c)(3) classification as a public charity organization.

At its inception, the organization contained alumni from the former Thyne Institute, the former Mecklenburg County Training School, the former West End High School, and the former East End High School as well as friendly supporters.

Our Vision

To display and preserve a Black History collection: in a facility open to the public and online, from four historically black schools for posterity, and to promote educational programs and activities.
